Training

Your success as a Sea Scout leader can be helped by taking various training courses provided by the Boy Scouts. Many Scouters report that they gain insight and learn techniques that benefit them in their jobs and dealing with their own children.

Orientation training:

- This is Scouting: An online introduction to the scouting program.
- Venturing Fast Start: An online introduction to the scouting programs open to teenage boys and girls.

Program specific training required for certification:

- Venturing Youth Protection Training (Y02): An online program illustrating the techniques for meeting the challenges of working with teens and presents the rules for conducting activities.
- Sea Scout Adult Leader Basic Training (P44): A classroom program for teaching the details of running a Sea Scout ship.

Advanced leadership training:

- Sea Badge: A nationally supervised weekend classroom program for experienced Sea Scouters that presents advanced management techniques.
- Sea Badge Underway: A nationally supervised weekend course held underway on a boat for experienced Sea Scouters that focuses on managing underway operations of a Sea Scout ship.
- Wood Badge: An internationally recognized 6-day course in executive management techniques as applied to scouting.

Supplemental training useful to Sea Scout leaders:

- Hazardous Weather: An online program teaching the techniques for recognizing hazardous weather and the guidelines for protection.
- Safety Afloat (SA): An online program teaching the rules for conducting safe boating activities.
- Safe Swim Defense (SSD): An online program teaching the rules for conducting safe aquatic activities.
- Trainer's EDGE: A classroom program that teaches skills useful for instructors and educators.

Every scout deserves a trained leader.
