Job Description:

The Troop Librarian takes care of troop literature.

Reports to: Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

Adult Mentor: Assigned by Scoutmaster

Troop Librarian Duties:

- Establish and take care of the troop library:
 - Keep records on literature owned by the troop
 - Add new or replacement items as needed
 - Keep books and pamphlets available for borrowing at troop meetings
 - Keep a system for checking books and pamphlets in and out
 - Follow up on late returns
- Regularly attend troop meetings, campouts, and other events during his service period
- Set a good example of the principles of Scouting
- Enthusiastically wear the Scout Uniform correctly
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show Scout spirit

Troop Librarian Qualifications:

- First Class scout or above
